



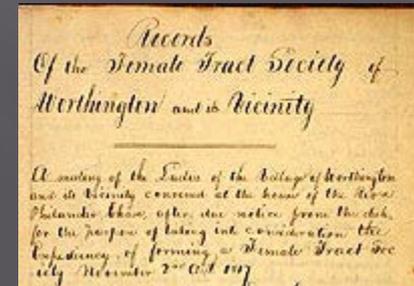

# OAIS

- **Open Reference Model Standard**
  - Public Process & Freely Available
- **Information**—any type of knowledge
  - Independent of the forms (phys/digital) used to represent the information
  - Data are the representation forms of information
- **Archival Information System**
  - Hard/software & people responsible for acquisition, preservation & dissemination of the information

# ISO 14721:2012

- **Provides a framework to:**
  - Understand archival concepts needed for long-term digital information preservation & access
  - Describe & compare architectures & operation of existing & future archives
  - Describe & compare different long-term preservation strategies & techniques
  - etc...

# WHAT IS THE OAIS MODEL?

- A reference model widely accepted by digital preservation community as a key standard for digital repositories.
- Specifies how digital assets should be preserved from digital ingestion through subsequent preservation strategies to the creation of an access methodology.
- A high-level reference/conceptual model--flexible enough for use in a wide variety of environments.

# PARTS OF THE OAIS MODEL

- Actors—the roles
  1. Producer—delivers content to the system
  2. Consumer—obtains content from the system
  3. Management—responsible for managing the system
- Information Packages—the content
- Actions—functions that take place in the Archives

# OAIS INFORMATION PACKAGES—THE CONTENT

- Submission Information Package (SIP)
- Dissemination Information Package (DIP)
- Archival Information Package (AIP)



# OAIS ACTIONS—THE FUNCTIONS

- Ingest—the content arrives
- Archival Storage—the content is stored/maintained
- Data Management
- Administration—how system is managed
- Access—how content is delivered
- Preservation Planning—how content is preserved
